1. How do the fulfilled prophecies of the Bible prove the inspiration of the Bible?
2. Do you think that spiritual interactions are occurring in the world today much as in the time of Daniel? If you think they are, how does that influence your prayer life and your attitude toward current events?
3. What are some spiritual interactions of God in the world that are evidence of His hand in bringing about His agenda much as in the time of Alexander the Great when his actions paved the way for the spread of the Gospel?
4. We know that God appoints all the leaders in the world (Rom 13). How does that knowledge influence your prayer life? Discuss some effects of leadership that seemed bad but ended with results that you can determine as good from God's perspective.
5. What criteria do you use to judge some leader's decisions? Be specific.
6. In Daniel's time marriage was an important political decision leading to increased governing areas and power. Do you see some similar interactions today?
7. How do persecutions influence someone to emphasize their faith to a greater degree than before the persecutions?
8. In this chapter we saw that the visions to Daniel prophesied events in secular history outside of the Bible's timeline. How does that influence your appreciation of these prophesies?
9. Christians faced death in Biblical times and today they still face death if they will not renounce their belief of God and their practice of their worship of Him. What would allow you to stand firm in the face of such a death?
10. Do you feel comfortable interpreting the predictions of the small horn as the actual Antiochus Epiphanes, the Roman Empire, or the Antichrist who will appear at the End Times? Be specific.
