7. How many invitations did a host send to people he wanted to come to his banquet? What was the significance to the host for the second one to be refused?
8. Discuss the three excuses given by people declining to come to the banquet. Which is the worse and why?
9. In verses 21-24 who are the people being invited to the banquet now? What type of people do these probably represent?
10. What is the most probably meaning of verse 24?
11. Why were large crowds following Jesus at this time in His ministry?
12. How do you understand the apparent conflict between loving your enemies and hating your families and friends?
13. Relate the building of a tower to discipleship to Jesus.
14. How can salt become non-salt and how does that relate to a false disciple?
15. What does it mean that only those who have ears to hear can hear?
