## Luke 22 Homework

- 1. What is the relationship between the Feast of Unleavened Bread and the Passover? Who were the religious leaders who took the initiative of taking care of Jesus? Why do you think they were chosen?
- **2.** We are not told when Satan entered Judas. When do you think this happened based upon Judas' actions? Why do you think Judas was chosen? What are some reasons you can deduce as to why Judas acted as he did?
- **3.** Was there anything unusual about a man carrying a pitcher of water? Why do you think the owner of the house freely gave them the room? What was involved in preparing the Passover?
- **4.** What is the "hour" of verse 14? Is there any indication that they were actually eating the Passover meal? What does the Greek construction of "earnestly desired" mean? What does John tell us that Jesus did during this last supper? Read over the Mark and Matthew reports of this last supper and see if you can determine whether or not this was a Passover meal.
- 5. What was the significance of Jesus first passing the cup to the disciples? What was the order of passing the wine and the bread in the three gospels and in 1 Cor 11:23-26? What prophecy does the blood offering fulfill?
- **6.** Since the process of the betrayal of Jesus was ordained, does this mean that Judas has no guilt? Explain. How did all the disciples betray Jesus?
- 7. Why did the disciples argue among themselves as to which was the greatest? How did the reply by Jesus about kings fit into this discussion? Who was the greatest in the group? What does Jesus mean about them ruling with Him over Israel?
- **8.** What is the significance of the word "you" being plural in verse 31? In verse 32 all the "you" words are now singular. How does that aid you in your interpretation? In verse 33 Peter said he was ready to die for Jesus but how did Jesus correct his attitude?
- **9.** Why does Jesus tell them to take provisions with them when they go out for Him later? What is the significance of taking a sword? How was Jesus numbered among the transgressors as stated in verse 37?
- **10.** Why do you think Luke does not tell us the Jesus took others with Him when He went to pray? How did Jesus show His total submission to the Father in the upcoming events? How did the Father comfort Jesus?
- **11.** Why did Judas greet Jesus with a kiss? How did Jesus model submission to the will of God? What does Matthew tell us about the actions of the disciples?
- **12.** To whom did Peter deny being a disciple of Jesus? How many times did he make such a denial? How was Peter identified? What do you think Jesus was thinking when He saw Peter after the denials?
- **13.** What was the first treatment Jesus received at the hands of His captors? Why are their accusations called blasphemous? What were the two questions the Council asked Jesus?
